Seven Core Principles of the Constitution Party

4. **Property**: Each individual's right to own and steward personal property without government burden.

6. **States' Rights**: Everything not specifically delegated by the Constitution to the federal government, nor prohibited by the Constitution to the states, is reserved to the states or to the people.
7. **American Sovereignty**: American government committed to the protection of the borders, trade, and common defense of Americans, and not entangled in foreign alliances.
