Robert is an experienced trial lawyer with a special interest in defending gun owners' rights:



State v. Deveaux (Delaware County)--Robert Owens defended a gun owner arrested in his home and charged with using a firearm while intoxicated. The homeowner was not intoxicated but had accidentally tripped his silent alarm. After a full jury trial, the Prosecutor was convinced to drop the charges and dismiss the case. The gun owner walked out of court with his gun in hand.



State v. Wolfe (Morrow County)—Robert Owens defended a gun owner indicted on felony gun charges, accused of a road rage incident with a gun. In point of fact, the gun owner used a hand gesture, not his single action Ruger "Vaquero." The case resolved with the gun owner paying a \$50 fine for a minor traffic ticket and obtaining a court order forcing the State Highway Patrol to return his firearm. Mr. Wolfe had the distinct pleasure to go to the Patrol barracks and have the Sergeant hand him back his gun and bullets!
